

### Egypt unveiled at full solar

eclipse: A solar eclipse visible from Luxor, a city deeply connected to the sun god Amun-Ra, adds a unique dimension to this trip. Watching from iconic sites like the Karnak and Luxor temples, the Valley of the Kings, and the Temple of Hatshepsut would be unforgettable. A cruise along the Nile would also provide travelers with a fantastic opportunity to see major sites, such as the temple of Abu Simbel, the Temple of Isis on Philae Island, and other ancient wonders like the pyramids of Giza and Sakkara. This rare alignment of a celestial event with Egypt's ancient history makes it a perfect time to visit.

#### MON JULY 26 DAY 1 - Cairo

Arrive in Cairo and check into your hotel. Steigenberger Tahrir Hotel

#### TUE JULY 27 DAY 2 - Cairo

Visit Khan El Kalili Market and Fatimid Cairo including El Moez Street Hotel.

Motorboat ride to the Island of Philae where we visit the temple of Isis, dedicated to the mother goddess Isis who gave birth here to her son Horus. We visit the unfinished obelisk and the granite quarries where the Egyptians cut their statues and obelisks.

#### FRI JULY 30 DAY 5 - Nile Cruise


Morning sail to Kom Ombo. After breakfast, visit the temple of Kom Ombo dedicated to the gods, Sobek and Horus. Sail to the city of Edfu. After lunch, horse buggies will roll you through the ancient city of Edfu to the temple of Horus and his consort Hathor.

#### SUN AUGUST 01 DAY 7 - Nile Cruise/Luxor

Visit to the West Bank of Luxor to see the Valley of the Kings which contains the exquisite tombs of the New Kingdom Pharaohs, the Valley of the Queens, and the Valley of the Nobles. Break for lunch at the historic courtyard of the venerable Sheikh Ali Restaurant. Following lunch, visit to the great mortuary temples of Hatshepsut.

#### MON AUGUST 02 DAY 8 - Nile Cruise/Luxor

Today we will sail several miles south of Luxor to the exact spot where you can watch the longest time of the full solar eclipse from our cruise sun deck. Sail to Dendarah.

#### **TUE AUGUST 03 DAY 9 - Nile Cruise**

Visit the Temple of the goddess Hathor, goddess of love, harmony, and music. On the ceiling of the temple, you find the oldest zodiac signs represented as the same ones we know today.

#### WED AUGUST 04 DAY 10 - Nile Cruise/Cairo

Check out from the Nile Cruise and drive to Abydos to visit the Temple of God Osiris, god of the underworld. Flight to Cairo.
